The Erode District Cooperative Milk Producers' Union Limited is a replica of the District Milk Unions in Gujarat State based on the famed 'AMUL' system.

The Erode Milk Union is, therefore, sandwiched in the middle of the 3-tier system popularly known as the 'ANAND' or "AMUL" pattern consisting of an apex State level Federation at Chennai, the Unions at the district level and the primary cooperative societies at the village level.
